LAURA ... WHO?

And so it begins

There she was, this young teenager. She may have looked reserved in the schoolyard, but this impression was deceptive: she was **focused** solely on the upcoming weekend, which she was anticipating with a joyful tingle.

It was Friday and the last school lesson was over. Now she had to rush home, because the Formula 1 World Championship final was just around the corner. The anticipation grew with every second. Two days full of emotion, top-class sport and pure **fascination** are laying ahead of her.

To get the right overview, one had to mark down the own statistics - pen and paper were already waiting to be used. Who would come out on top in the championship? Talking shop with her best buddies, Laura was now completely immersed in her world:

"Motorsport gripped me like a virus. One day I just had to sit in a racing car and go racing!"

For a long time, however, Laura's only connection to motorsport was watching: Neither her family nor her friends had any contact with racing. But the young woman saw a way from the television to the racetrack: work hard and earn the necessary money.







From TV to the Green Hell

She soon finished her studies and the wages from her first job were invested directly in karting. From 2008, Laura took part in countless kart races and gained technical know-how and tactical skills in team races at home and abroad. The result: several trophies in endurance races and podiums in 24-hour races with various international karting teams.

In 2016, the long years of saving finally bore fruit: Laura fought her way from karting into her first racing cockpit. In the ADAC Dacia Logan Cup, she successfully navigated her way through a wide variety of racing situations right from the start.

In 2017, Laura entered "sacred terrain" for the first time: the Nürburgring Nordschleife. In a BMW Z4, she earned the next important licenses. Every euro was put aside - which in the end enabled her to race in the RCN

In 2018 she switched to the BMW M235i Racing Cup Class.

In 2019, the Offenbach native competed in her first three VLN races, this season in the BMW M240i Racing Cup. She also cleared another important hurdle: obtaining Permit A.

In 2020 and 2021, Laura took part in the NLS 6h race and the NLS doubleheader, where she finished 3rd in her class.

In 2023, the time had come: the 24-hour race at the Nürburgring took place in front of an audience again after the pandemic. And Laura was there too. As part of the Adrenalin Motorsport team, she was at the wheel of a BMW M240i and drove in both the qualifying race and the 24-hour race on the Nürburgring Nordschleife to 3rd place in the BMW M240i class.

And now? Laura also wants to compete in international 24-hour races.



What are important values for you?

Honesty, empathy, discipline, perseverance and team spirit."

On the one hand, my primary goal is to race. On the other hand, I want to offer added value with my other skills. My endless enthusiasm and passion help me to combine all of this."

How do you reconcile all that?

For me, everything I do alongside my job and racing are the building blocks on the way to my goal. At work, I have to be super organized, disciplined and connected.

Besides, I never really rest, and this ambition is ultimately the key to success. On top of it, everything that has to do with motorsport is great fun for me!"

What fulfills you the most?

I am often asked by my peers or younger people how I made it into racing. For many, it's a dream, but very few actually take the first step. Then I tell my story and usually get a lot of admiration from the other person.

I want to encourage these people by leading by example."

What sets you apart from the masses of racing drivers?

I see my goals in a broader context. I want to encourage people to get the best out of themselves and consciously steer their lives in the direction they choose. I want to show that it's worth sticking to your goals and persevering."

Laura's job as a **F1 Paddock Club Expert Host** has fulfilled two great wishes: who doesn't dream of being able to follow the Formula 1 Grands Prix around the world? She can also pass on her knowledge and passion here.

This time not on asphalt, but very close to the track: the Hessian is able to demonstrate her expertise and spontaneity when commentating on various real racing and sim racing events. For example, the ADAC SimRacing Cup and other international sim racing formats. She is also on site at the track for DMV races as a track commentator which is streamed live on YouTube.

The next time Laura sits in a racing car herself, she likes to have a co-driver next to her: as a **race taxi driver**, she lets her guests experience the thrill of speed up close.
